ARTISTIKA OF THE SEA

Circus has become more than a circus attraction. It is the high art that human bodies rapture the physical laws and captivate the young and old audience. Years of discipline and hard training combined with great talent and gracefulness celebrates under the circus domes around the world triumph over gravity. Often the artists tell little stories devotedly and with love. With the ease of a ballet dancer and the expressiveness of an actor they connect all sorts of the performing arts - staged to the point, with the right and sometimes especially composed music.

Far from the circus roof the artists show their skills, direct, close and without double bottom. Six selected stars of artistic scene will compete at the Artistika of the Sea to the highly doped trophy. Also, it will not be easy for the international jury to select the winner. In addition to the judgment of the jury and the audience will vote its winner.

The international jury will not only determine the winner and distribute a prize money, but also demonstrate their skills.

GÜNTER JAUCH, WINEGROWER

The 'Weingut von Otheграven' was founded around 1500 by the von Metzenhausen-von Hagen family. This makes it one of the region's oldest vineyards - the first documented evidence of viticulture in Kanzem an der Saar dates back to 1381. After a long and tumultuous history, the vineyard became the property of the Grach-Weissebach-von Otheграven family in 1805.

The company was a founding member of the Association of German Prädikat Wine Estates (VDP).

The grand building, the park and the Kanzemer Altenberg vineyard are listed as an ensemble.

Weingut von Otheграven owns properties in four renowned areas of the Saar: Kanzemer Altenberg, Wawerner Herrenberg, Ockfener Bockstein and Wiltinger Kupp, with 100% Riesling vines. The wines are then spontaneously fermented using the vineyard's own yeast.

In 2010, Günther Jauch and his wife Thea took over Weingut von Otheграven from Dr Heidi Kegel. Günther Jauch's grandmother was born into the von Otheграven family, and he and wife are taking the vineyard into its 7th generation.
